



2010 AAMD EDUCATION AND RESEARCH FOUNDATION GUNILLA BENTEL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Eligibility requirements:

- Any currently accepted or enrolled student in a JRCERT accredited Medical Dosimetry program in fall 2009. Applicants must be a member of AAMD in good standing at the time of application and award.
- The scholarships may be awarded only to those students who will employ them to continue their formal medical dosimetry education.
- Selection is based on the applicant's justification of award, educational plan, academic performance and standing, potential for development, leadership capacity and AAMD activities.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form.
- Personal statement (1000 to 1,500 words) addressing why the award should be given to the applicant, the applicant's interest in Medical Dosimetry and plans for continuing formal education.
- Document the cost of tuition, fees and books. Please be as detailed as possible.
- Minimum of three sealed letters of recommendation; one must be from the student's Program or Department Director, and the others may be from other faculty members or colleagues.
- One official transcript from your most recently attended educational institution.
- Résumé. Include honors, activities, organizations, AAMD activities (including any volunteer positions held), and work experience.

Procedure:

One complete application package containing one original of all items listed above must be received by AAMD Foundation by the deadline. **All items must be collected by the applicant and sent to AAMD Foundation as one complete application package.** Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

Award:

Scholarships will be awarded based upon funds available and may be awarded to one or more recipients. The funds are to be used for tuition, fees and books and will be disbursed in the spring 2010 term. The award amount will vary depending on the program with the maximum award valued at \$5000.00. All award decisions made by the AAMD Education and Research Foundation Board are final. The Board is under no obligation to award a scholarship in any particular year.
