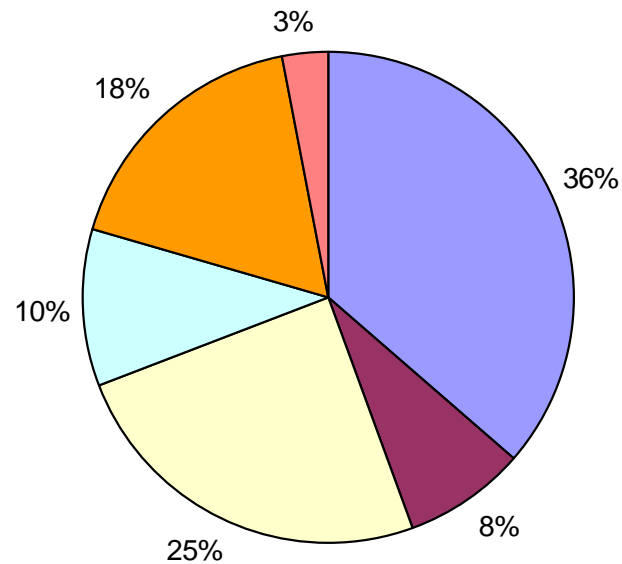

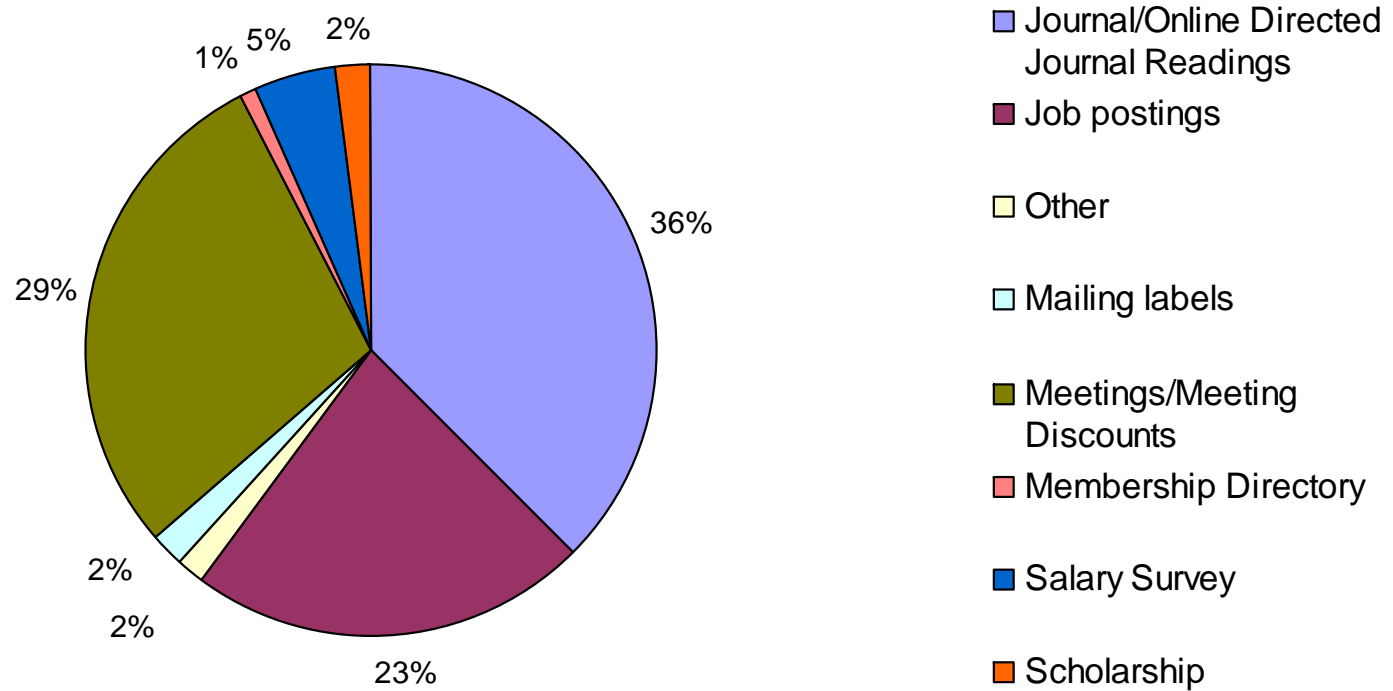

## What is the most important reason for having an AAMD Membership?

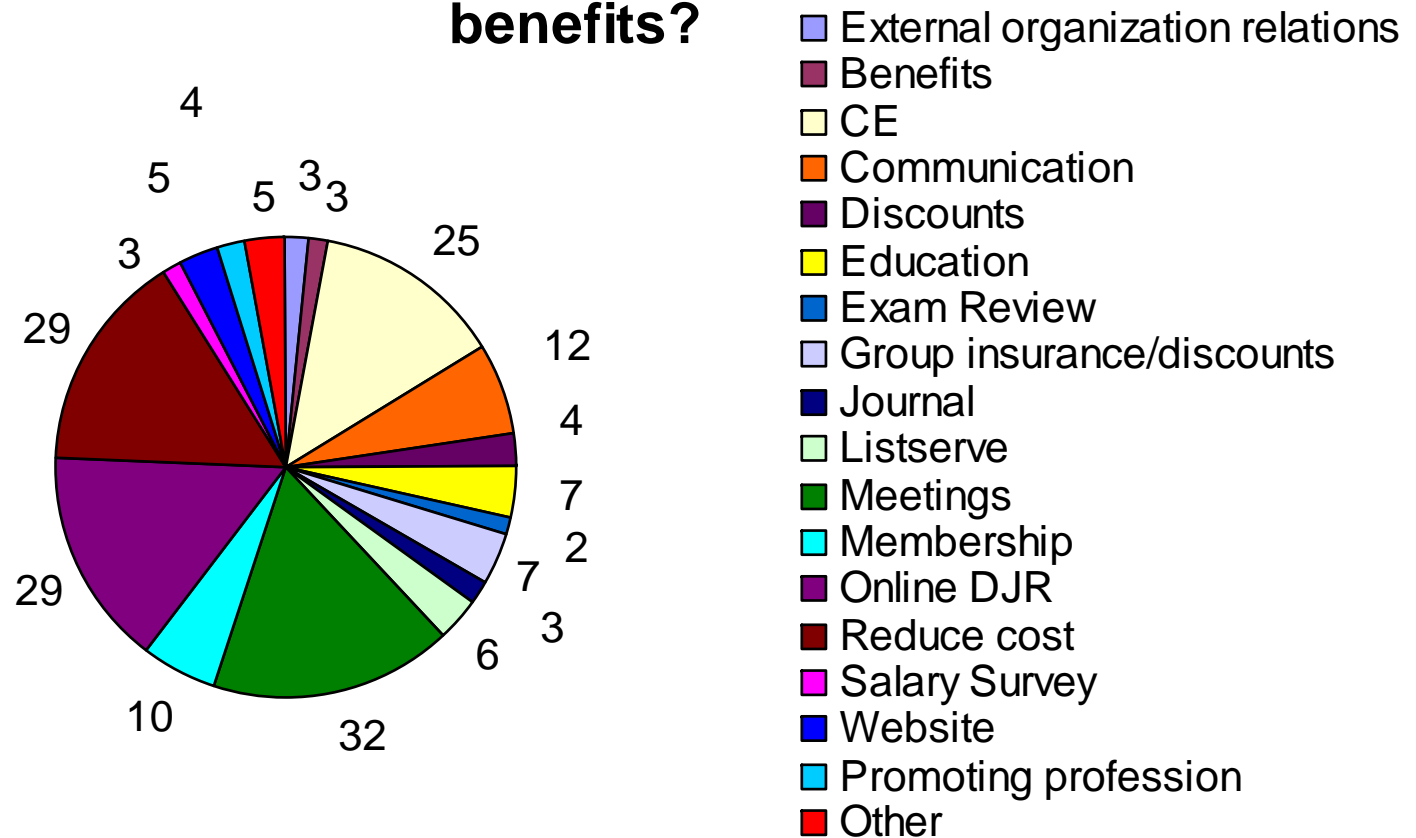

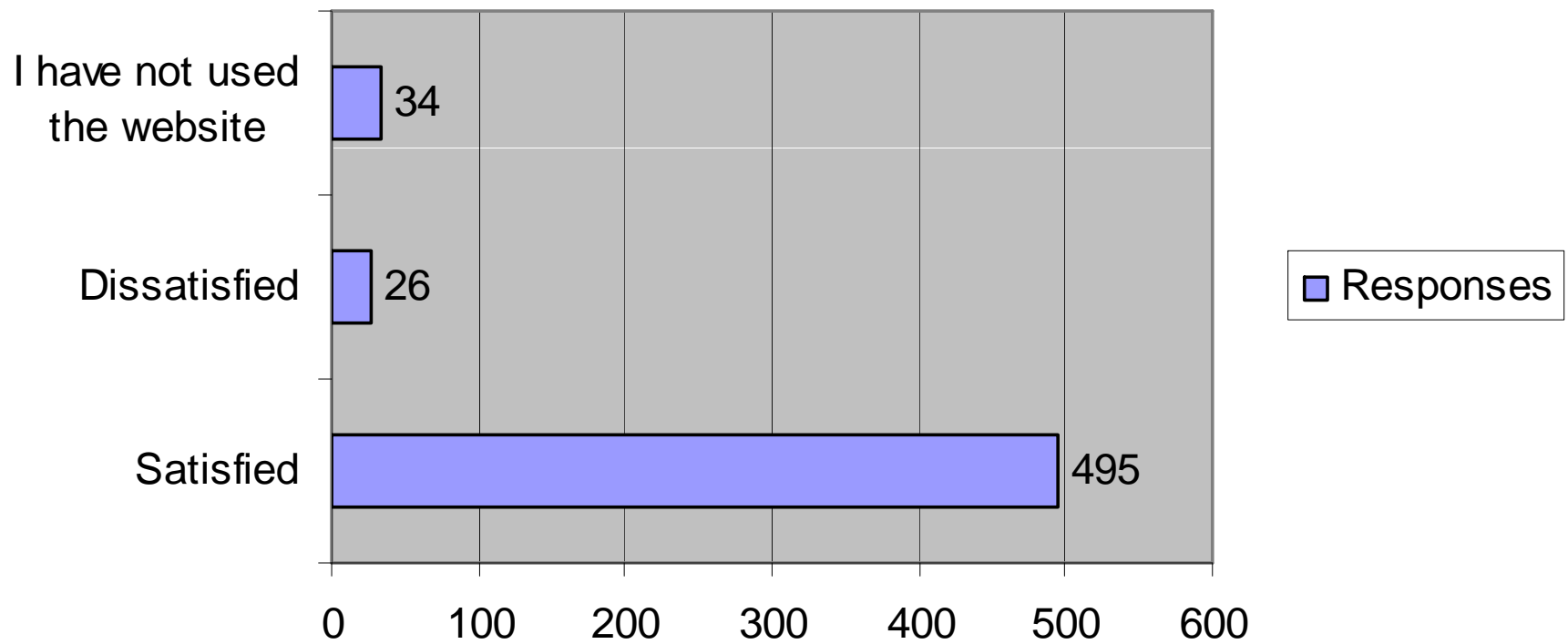
## What benefits of your membership do you NOT use?



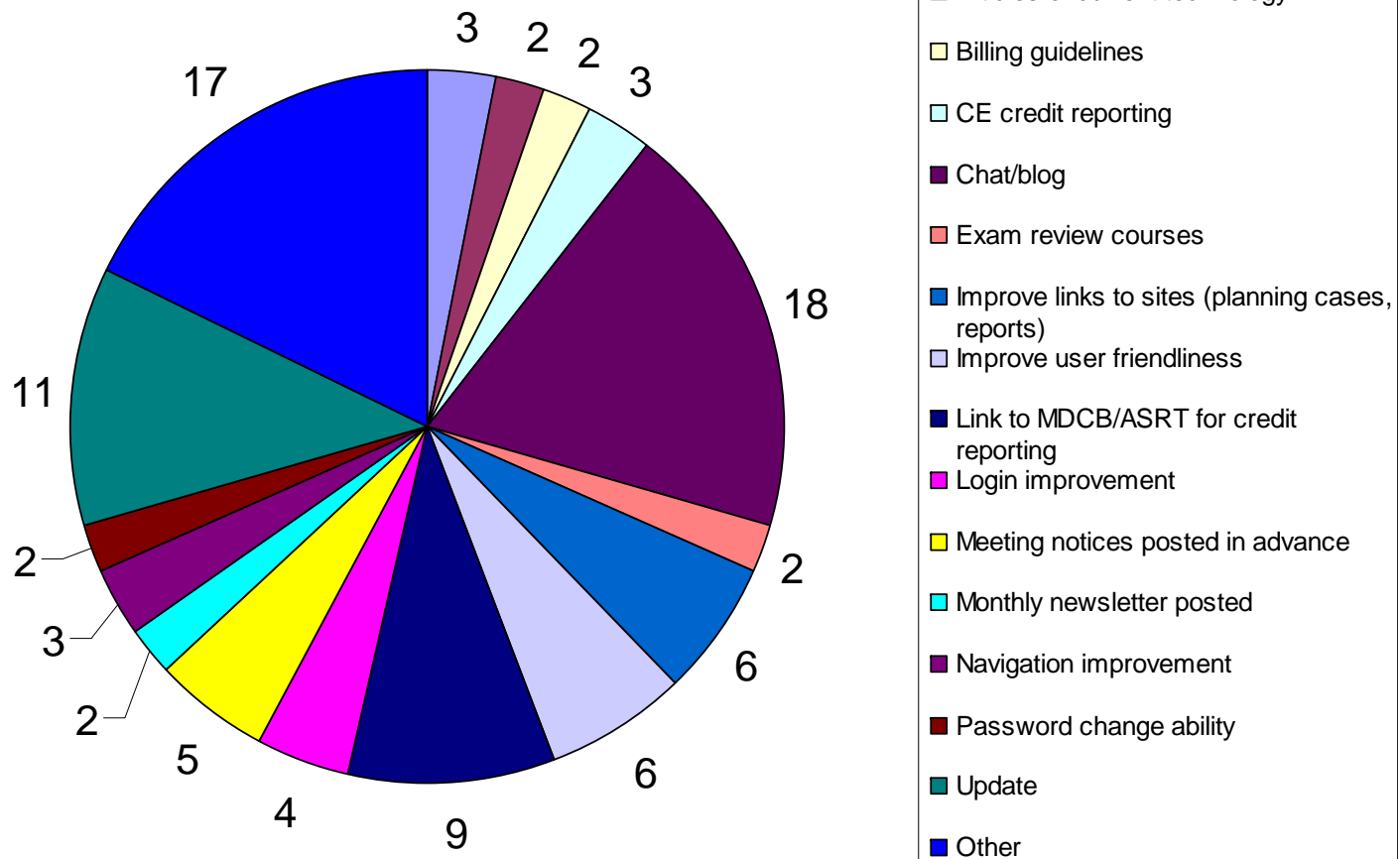
## How can the AAMD improve upon membership benefits?



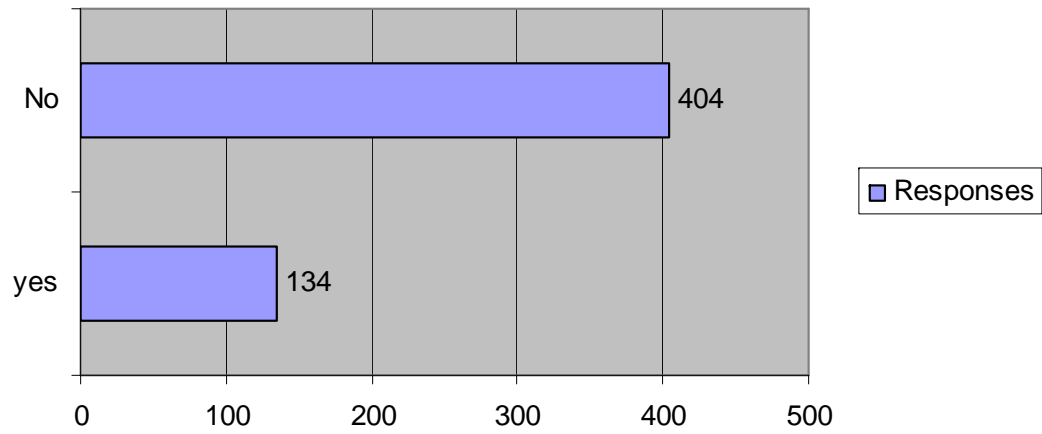
## Overall, how satisfied are you with the usability of the website?



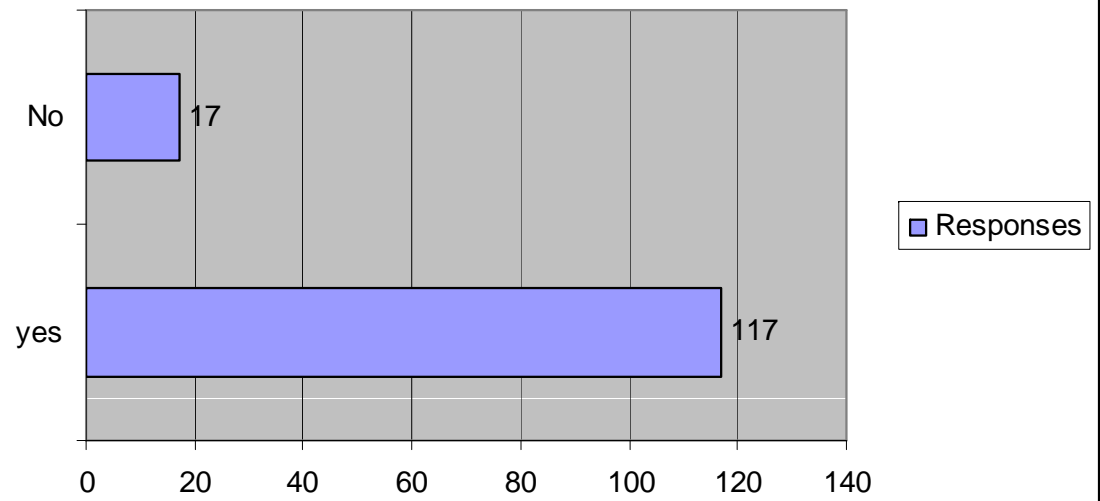

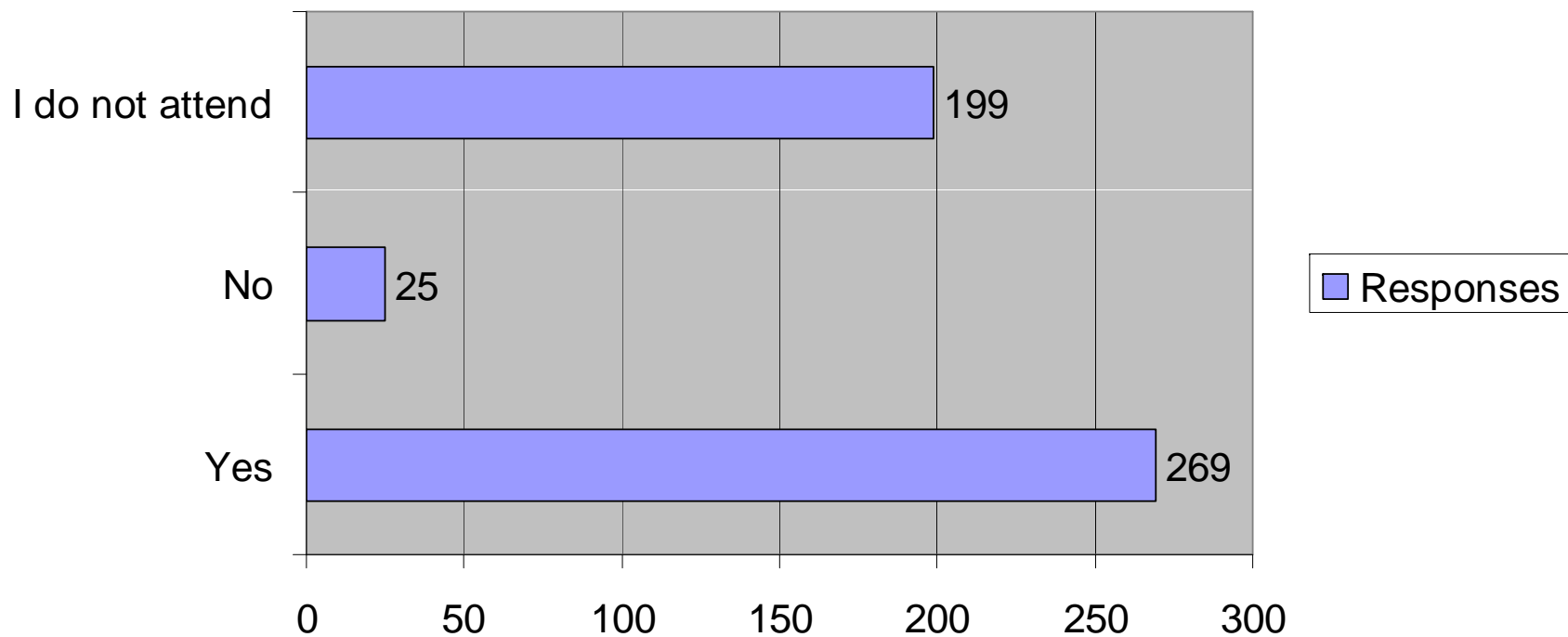
